RULES OF THE WATER

If you have the good fortune of owning, renting or visiting the Townsend Flowage, (full recreational body of water) please be respectful by following the **RULES OF THE WATER** and the Town Ordinance.

Counter clockwise for all boats and jet skis make busy weekends much safer and is considered courteous to all using the water.

Before 10am and after 5pm is considered **SLOW NO WAKE** for boaters, Jet Ski's and fisherman.

Buoys marked SLOW NO WAKE (5 mph) are placed in narrow channels to decrease owner's loss of land due to the waves created.

Please anticipate the reduced speed well before the buoy out of consideration of landowners.

If you are within 100 feet of a dock or shoreline a SLOW NO WAKE policy is in effect at all times.

If you are pulling a tube or skier **they must be 100 feet** from another person, boat or dock.

Anyone born after 1988 and between the ages of 12 and 16 must complete an in person class with a passing grade in order to drive/operate a jet ski, boat or pontoon.

Anyone born after 1988 Age 16 and over must attend an online boater safety class with a passing grade in order to drive/operate a jet ski, boat or pontoon.
